

Critical Care Fellowship Program for Emergency Medicine Graduates

The Departments of [Emergency Medicine](#) and [Anesthesiology's](#) Division of [Critical Care Medicine](#) at Shands Hospital at the University of Florida are seeking EM residency-trained or board-certified emergency physicians as applicants for our joint [Critical Care / Emergency Medicine Fellowship](#) at Shands University of Florida in Gainesville. Our Emergency / Critical Care Medicine program emphasizes management in surgical critical care, including our Level 1 Trauma Center Emergency Department. Qualified applicants will be board eligible or certified in emergency medicine; preferred applicants will have a demonstrated academic career interest. This two-year program includes training in surgical, burn, cardiac, hyperbaric critical care, research, EMS, Emergency Department and Pediatric Critical Care. SUF Department of Emergency Medicine provides land, aeromedical and tactical EMS direction, providing medical support teams for NASA shuttle launches and landings.

The program is directed by Doctors A. Joseph Layon, Chief of the Division of Critical Care Medicine and Director of Surgical Critical Care at Shands at UF, and Kevin L. Ferguson of Emergency Medicine. Fellows will be involved in resident conferences, simulation and procedure labs, as well clinical teaching and supervision in the Emergency Department. Both Departments are involved in research including resuscitation, brain injury, lung injury, and medical education. Fellows will be active research partners with our departments' faculties.
